

Andreas Kakouris

High Commissioner of the Republic of Cyprus in the UK



Ambassador Kakouris started his diplomatic career in 1984 as Vice Consul in New York with parallel accreditation to the United Nations and covered successive UN General Assembly Sessions from 1984 to 1991.

He has served as High Commissioner in the UK since September 2019 and has been posted previously as Ambassador to the United States, to Sweden and to Ireland. Other diplomatic posts were as Deputy Chief of

Mission to Washington and at the Embassy in Belgium with concurrent accreditation to the European Communities.

Prior to coming to London, he was the Director for the Middle East and Africa Division. He has also held the positions of Director of the Cyprus Problem and Turkey Division, Director of the Diplomatic Office of the Minister of Foreign Affairs and Political Director (Multilateral Affairs).

Ambassador Kakouris received his BA in Politics from Lancaster University and a MA in International Affairs from Carleton University, Ottawa, Canada.
